	<p><b>Mother's Day/carers event/stall.</b> Held in Term 2 in the week leading up to Mother's Day. Can be an event for mums (offsite), or a stall (onsite). The stall requires the purchasing, wrapping, set up and selling of gifts to students at the Mother's Day stall. The stall is held during the daytime on school grounds.</p>
	<p><b>School Disco.</b> Held in Term 2. This is specifically for children and is usually held on the weekend. You will be responsible for selling tickets, decorating, catering and drinks for the night, booking DJ/band and running a raffle for the event</p>
	<p><b>Father's Day/carers event/stall</b> Held in Term 3 in the week leading up to Father's Day. Can be an event for dad's (offsite), or a stall (onsite). The stall requires the purchasing, wrapping, set up and selling of gifts to students at the Father's Day stall. The stall is held during the daytime on school grounds.</p>
	<p><b>Urban Bush Dash.</b> A funrun held in August and is open to the community as well. People who like to organise bigger events would be perfect for this</p>
	<p><b>Bottles for Books Campaign.</b> Held all year round, this campaign seeks to improve recycling practices around the school and during events. Organisers will be responsible for the collection of recyclables and depositing them into the recycling depots, collecting money for the school.</p>
	<p><b>P&amp;C Working Bee.</b> Held throughout the year, and can involve gardening, or cleaning up P&amp;C stock. Can be 1 or 2, depending on the need.</p>
	<p><b>Great Pie and Lamington Drive.</b> Held during Term 2. This is held online and requires collating orders and organising a delivery date for parents to come and collect at the school.</p>
	<p><b>Trivia Night.</b> This is an adult's only event! It is loads of fun and people from all years are encouraged to get involved. You will be responsible for picking the theme, organising catering, beverages, booking the trivia host and running a silent auction. This requires some support from the community to donate prizes for auction.</p>
	<p><b>World Teacher's Day.</b> Happens in October, and is a simple, easy event to show thanks to the teachers throughout the year. Usually consists of breakfast or treat for teachers on the day</p>
	<p><b>Mango Drive.</b> Held during Term 4 (November delivery, pending mango season). This is held online and requires collating orders and organising a delivery date for parents to come and collect at the school.</p>
	<p><b>NSS Christmas Raffle.</b> This raffle is run for the duration of Term 4, with winners announced at the end of the year. You will be responsible for finding prizes, selling tickets, promoting the raffle and partaking in drawing the winners!</p>
