This funding will be used to

- Maintain the percentage of students meeting the national minimum standard in Numeracy (100% in Year 3 and Year 5)
- Increase the percentage of students meeting the national minimum standard in Reading (96% in Year 3 and 92% in Year 5)
- Increase the percentage of students in U2B in Reading, Numeracy and Spelling
Year 3 Reading 42% - 50% Numeracy 46% -50% Spelling 44% - 48%
Year 5 Reading 67% - 70% Numeracy 62% - 65% Spelling 54% - 57%
- Increase the % of students in Prep achieving a PM reading level of 9 or above (2014 - 71% to 2015 -74%)

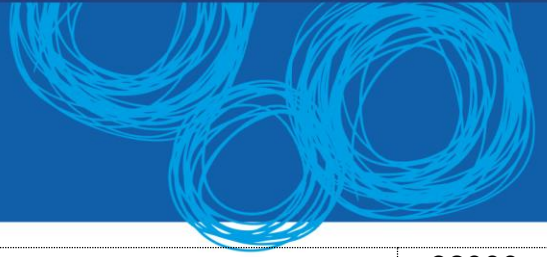
Our strategy will be to

- Build capacity across the school to use the range of data available to address the learning needs in Reading, Spelling and Numeracy
- Release personnel with the requisite skills to build capacity in classroom practice in the teaching of reading, spelling and numeracy
- Employ teacher aides to increase the number of hours that identified students have access to intervention, support or extension
- Implement a consistent school wide pedagogy in the teaching of reading, spelling and numeracy
- Embed the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching reading in the Early Years – blending, segmenting and syllabification
- Purchase relevant and recommended resources to support student learning
- Provide relevant and targeted professional development
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students identified as EALD learners
